## IDAHO STATE MUSEUM

The Idaho State Museum reopened on October 12, 2018 after undergoing a \$17 million renovation and expansion. This is the first complete renovation of the museum since it opened in 1950. The new exhibitions reflect the premise that people and the land shape each other. Idaho’s story is told geographically focused on northern Idaho, central Idaho, and southern Idaho. This story is the work of years of scholarly research, community focus groups, and input from community, tribal, and business leaders. New exhibitions in the Idaho State Museum will engage visitors through a variety of methods. Visitors will actually be able to feel the heat of the “Big Burn,” take a ride on a Salmon River Scow, or turn off the water to Shoshone Falls.

The International Dark-Sky Association (IDA) is the recognized authority on light pollution and is the leading organization combating light pollution worldwide. In 2017, three distinct areas in Idaho were recognized by the IDA as offering excellent opportunities for night sky viewing:

- Central Idaho - Reserve
- Ketchum, Idaho - Community
- Craters of the Moon National Monument - Park

Idaho's dark skies can also be enjoyed outside of these designated areas. Whether camping or enjoying an evening stroll, Idaho's starry skies are sure to impress.
